

## COOKIE POLICY

This Cookie Policy aims to describe to the user/visitor (hereinafter referred to as "**User**") of the site [www.lorettadenarditraduzioni.it](http://www.lorettadenarditraduzioni.it) (hereinafter referred to as "**Site**") the methods of managing cookies.

This information is provided in light of the provision of the Data Protection Authority of 8 May 2014 (hereinafter referred to as "**Provision**"), which sets out the "Identification of simplified methods for the information and acquisition of consent for the use of cookies", the provisions of EU Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter referred to as "**GDPR**") applicable as from 25 May 2018, and the requirements of Italian legislation on personal data protection, to the extent that they will be valid and effective following the entry into force of the GDPR.

The User is invited to carefully read this Cookie Policy before proceeding to surfing the Site.

### WHAT IS A COOKIE?

Cookies are small text files that are placed on the User's device when the User visits a website. At each subsequent visit, the cookies are sent back to the website that originated them (first-party cookies) or to another website that recognizes them (third-party cookies). Cookies serve various purposes such as enabling efficient surfing between pages, storing favorite sites, and generally enhancing the browsing experience. They also help provide advertising content tailored to the User's interests. Based on their function and the entity that created them, cookies can be categorized into technical cookies, analytical cookies, profiling cookies, first-party cookies, and third-party cookies.

### TECHNICAL COOKIES

Technical cookies are those cookies whose storage does not require the User's prior consent. This category includes so-called essential cookies, which are not strictly necessary and enable functions without which a complete use of the Site would not be possible. Essential technical cookies are used exclusively by Mrs. Loretta De Nardi and are therefore first-party cookies. These cookies are saved on the User's computer (or on another device) only during individual browser use sessions. A technical cookie of this kind is also used to store the User's consent to the use of cookies on the Site. Essential technical cookies cannot be disabled using the functions of the Site.

### THIRD-PARTY COOKIES

During the surfing of the Site, the User may receive on their device cookies from third-party sites or web servers (so-called "third-party cookies"): this occurs because the Site may contain elements such as images, maps, sounds, specific links to web pages of other domains, which are hosted on servers different from the one on which the requested page is located. In other words, these cookies are set directly by operators of websites or servers other than the Site. These operators or servers may set cookies while the User is visiting the Site and thus obtain information related to the fact that the User has visited the Site. The User will find more information on the use of third-party cookies by accessing the indicated link.

Most browsers are set to automatically accept cookies. The User can change this setting to block cookies or to prevent certain cookies from being stored on their device. There are several ways to manage cookies. The User can refer to the

technical guide and/or the help screen of their browser to manage or change the browser settings. In the case of different devices (for example, computers, smartphones, tablets, etc.), the User must ensure that the browser settings of each device are configured to reflect their cookies preferences.
